ARROWSTREET ANNOUNCES OFFICIAL GROUNDBREAKING OF FREEPORT VILLAGE STATION

The construction of Freeport Village Station, Freeport's newest retail development, was officially marked at a groundbreaking ceremony this morning. The Arrowstreet design team, Maine Governor John Baldacci, L.L. Bean President and CEO Chris McCormick, Developer Berenson Associates, Inc. , and numerous Freeport town representatives were in attendance.

Designed by Arrowstreet, the new development will offer an additional 120,000 square feet of retail and incorporate 550 parking spaces to support the increased number of expected visitors to the leisure travel destination. Historically, retail spaces in Freeport have been small - Village Station will provide larger retail areas to attract contemporary tenants to the market. Among the retailers are Phillips Van-Heusen Corporation, Brooks Brothers, Nike, and L.L. Bean's Freeport Outlet.

Planned in conjunction with L.L. Bean, the development's pedestrian-friendly connection to Main Street and the L.L. Bean campus across the street will maintain the New England town feel while offering tourists diverse activities and modern shopping amenities.

Arrowstreet is a multidisciplinary design firm based in Somerville, MA. Since 1961, the firm's designs have been based on a unique approach: look beyond traditional architectural and planning concerns into the underlying political, economic, and social issues which affect the success of a project.
