## Opening of Fairmont Battery Wharf Brings Contemporary Elegance to Boston's North End

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Fairmont Battery Wharf, Boston's newest waterfront hotel, welcomed its first guests on Monday, December 15th. Located in the historic North End, the 150-room hotel brings the highest of luxury service standards to this desirable location.

Arrowstreet's unique interior design for the boutique-style hotel conjures a sense of simple elegance on the waterfront. The design achieves this effect with rich woods, layered fabrics, and stones from around the world that add warmth to a contemporary setting. The double-height lobby is a luxurious space furnished in plush textures of deep reds. The tiered reception desk, inspired by the undulations of the building's roof, features a Van Gogh blue stone face and mother of pearl tile back-drop. Guest rooms are appointed with a magnificent leather platform bed with crisp, imported, Italian linens, and an elegantly upholstered headboard wall.

Fairmont Battery Wharf's signature restaurant, Sensing, opened this month under the leadership of internationally acclaimed chef, Guy Martin. Sensing will be a counterpart to the Michelin chef's Paris establishment by the same name. The 80-seat restaurant is distinguished from the richer woods of the hotel by its soft, light woods, celadon walls, and a bar that incorporates tiger's eye and white onyx.
